* Also, a hard copy of a pet photo and what they mean to you for a display in church might be good. Bring the photo next time you are with us

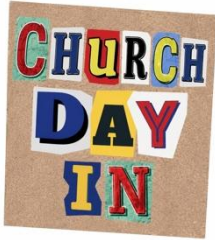


Kneelers
