We will be collecting food for the local Food Bank and donations will go to Water Aid.

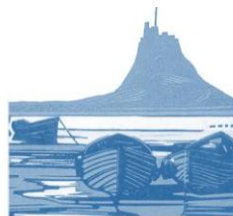
